

It is with heartfelt gratitude that we share an update from our foundation created to honor the memory and legacy of Reagan Delaney Tokes.

We were lucky to have been able to host our second annual Rally for Reagan event in Columbus, Ohio on February 29, 2020. We were the last event that was able to be held at the Renaissance Hotel before they had to cancel all upcoming events. Unfortunately, we were not as lucky in Maumee, Ohio. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, we had to cancel our third annual Rally for Reagan event in Maumee, Ohio which was to be held March 20-22, 2020. Despite this unfortunate situation, our sponsors and attendees allowed us to retain the proceeds from their contributions and ticket sales they had already submitted. Because of this graciousness from our Maumee supporters, along with the generocity, attendance and proceeds from our Columbus event, we were still able to support the number of students in 2020 we had previously forecasted.

A \$50,000 contribution was sent to the Reagan Delaney Tokes Memorial Scholarship Fund at The Ohio State University, taking the total amount of the endowment fund at this school to \$200,000. This additional contribution allows us to regularly award two scholarship recipients each year, with the continuation of support to each one of these students every year throughout their tenure at Ohio State.

In addition, we were able to support 10 individual graduating senior students who attended Anthony Wayne High School, Perrysburg High School and Maumee United Methodist Church Youth Program. We are immensely proud to have accomplished this, despite our event challenges this year.

Again, none of these incredible acts of support would be possible without the amazing, generous contributions we receive each year.
